After watching this tutorial video by **Andy Edmonds**, you will master the use of the site and be able to easily answer some basic questions, such as:

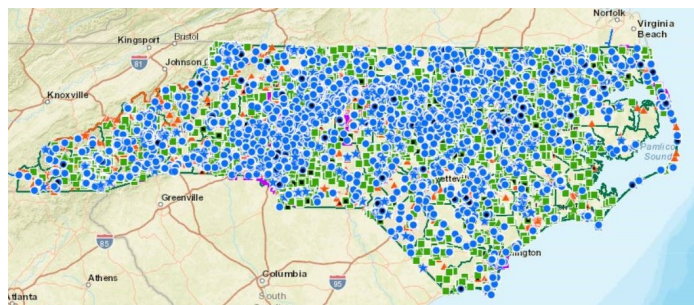
Is my house or building within a National Register or Local Historic District?
